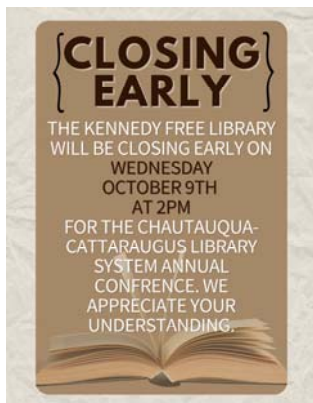

Elsy is sure that's why she must be here: to help bring the town to its storybook ending.

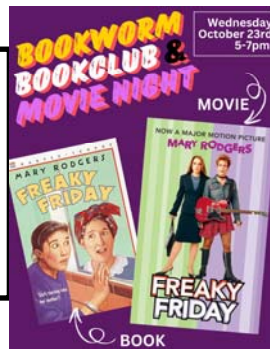
